## Activities & Events

**Networking:** Peer contacts allow members to learn from and support each other.

**Training Workshops:** Training workshops are held regionally to assist all State Park non-profit organizations.

**Annual Conference:** Hosted by a member association, the conference is the prime networking and learning opportunity for CALPA members.

**Park Advocacy Day:** An annual event that brings together park supporters from throughout California to advocate for the protection and enhancement of California's 279 State Parks.

**Resource Library:** We have a library of books, videos and tapes on non-profit management topics available free to members.

## League Structure

The League is a volunteer group formed in 1983 to serve as an “umbrella” support organization. Our membership currently consists of 61 of the 82 Cooperating Associations affiliated with parks throughout California.

The Board consists of six elected Executive Officers serving two-year terms (President, Secretary, Treasurer, VP Development, VP Membership and VP Regional Affairs) as well as 2 or 3 regional representatives from each of the League's regions and two at-large appointed committee chairs.

The regions are San Diego, Los Angeles, Monterey/Morro Bay, San Francisco Bay, Sacramento Area, and Northern California.
